

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOV. 25, 2019-The Crow Tribal Court publicly reprimanded lay advocate Michelle Wilson on November 25, 2019. Wilson was reprimanded for her actions in two cases which were found to violate the Crow Tribal Rules of Professional Conduct. In its Judgement, the Court took judicial notice of the fact that this was not the first time it had been called to investigate and make determinations on the fitness of this particular advocate for substantially similar violations of the Crow Tribal Court Rules of Professional Conduct. In addition to the Public Censure, Wilson was ordered to apologize to the complainants, refund their money, and was suspended from practicing law in the Crow Tribal Court for a period of at least one-year; which could become indefinitely, depending on Wilson's compliance with the Court's order for repayment.
